Eric Benchimol is a pediatric gastroenterologist at the SickKids Inflammatory Bowel Disease Centre and Professor in the Department of Paediatrics and the Institute for Health Policy, Management and Evaluation at the University of Toronto. He has an active practice caring for children and youth with inflammatory bowel disease (IBD). He is also Senior Scientist at the SickKids Research Institute, and Senior Core Scientist at ICES. Dr. Benchimol is also an epidemiologist, and chairs the Canadian Gastro-Intestinal Epidemiology Consortium (CanGIEC), which conducts epidemiology, pharmacoepidemiology, outcomes, and health services research using the health administrative data from multiple provinces. By using novel distributed network methodology, CanGIEC is able to assess the national picture of IBD in Canada despite the provincial nature of our health system.

Dr. Benchimol is the Past Chair of Crohn's and Colitis Canada (CCC) Scientific and Medical Advisory Council, and also co-chaired the CCC COVID-19 Task Force. In that capacity, he was involved in creating COVID-19 recommendations for patients with IBD, and health care providers (crohnsandcolitis.ca/covid19). He was also co-host of CCC's COVID-19 webinar series.
