



Speaker: Professor Sirinuch Chomtho, MD PhD

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Sirinuch Chomtho is Professor in Pediatrics at Chulalongkorn University. She is the head of Pediatric Nutrition Research Unit and the Division of Nutrition, Department of Pediatrics, Faculty of Medicine, Chulalongkorn University in Bangkok, Thailand. She finished her medical and pediatric training from the Faculty of Medicine, Chulalongkorn University. From 2003-2008, she was a research fellow at the MRC Childhood Nutrition Research Center, Institute of Child Health, University College London, UK. She obtained her PhD from the University College London in 2006 and the Diploma in pediatric nutrition from the UK Royal College of Pediatric and Child Health in 2007. Her research interest includes the effects of early nutrition on long-term health, breastfeeding medicine, obesity, inherited metabolic disorders and the ketogenic diet. To date, she has published 48 original articles and 23 book chapters. She has a lot of experience in dealing with children with obesity and has conducted several clinical trials in this area over the past 2 decades. She is currently a scientific committee of the Pediatric Nutrition Association of Thailand and the Asian Pan-Pacific Society for Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition.
