

Brief CV: Professor Way Seah Lee

Professor Lee Way Seah is Senior Professor at Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, University Tunku Abdul Rahman (UTAR), Malaysia and Honorary Professor in Paediatrics, Department of Paediatrics, Faculty of Medicine, University Malaya, Kuala Lumpur. He has been practicing pediatric gastroenterology, hepatology, and nutrition for more than 25 years. His main research interest is pediatric inflammatory bowel disease, neonatal and childhood liver disease, and childhood nutrition. Professor Lee has published more than 110 articles in academic journals as well as edited 4 textbooks in general paediatrics and paediatric gastroenterology/hepatology. He is a past President of College of Paediatrics, Academy of Medicine of Malaysia, a Commonwealth Scholar and a Fulbright Scholar. He is currently a council member and Secretary General of Asian Pan-Pacific Society for Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition (APPSPGHAN). In 2016, Professor Lee became the second paediatrician in Malaysia to be elected as a Fellow to the prestigious Academy of Sciences of Malaysia.
